

Training Rates and Explanations

All fees due on the 1st of every month before start of service

Training Rates:

- \$675 mo. Full Training Program: Riding, Lesson, or exercising 5 days a week
- \$575/mo. Training: Riding, Lesson, or exercising 4 days a week
- \$475/mo. Training: Riding, Lesson, or exercising 3 days a week
- \$350/mo. Lay-ups/daily hand walking, medicating, grooming, etc.
- \$150/mo Extra Feeding of Quality supplements for competition horses in training

All Training Programs Include:

- Grooming (mane pulling, show clipping, bathing, overall cleanliness, hoof care)
- Blanketing, use of Splint boots, grooming supplies, fly sprays, shampoos, liniments, etc,
- Medications administered when needed
- Turn-outs when needed during the week and at least 1 of the horses days off.

Board Rates:

- \$495/mo Box Stall
- \$520/mo Box stall with walk out area
- \$495 Pipe Stall with walk out area
- \$440/mo Paddock with shelter

Services available at an additional charge:

- \$150 Full body clipping
- \$100 Horse Purchase Evaluation (plus travel expenses)
- Blanket cleaning and repair
- Medications, Worming, and Medical supplies
- Sales Commission 10%. A 15% commission is charged if we are acting as agent for both buyer and seller- (7.5% on each side)

Lesson Services:

- \$60/ Jumping lesson with Trainer. Use of trainer's horse \$10 extra
- \$50/ Beginner lesson
- Private lessons @ 45 minutes, Group lessons @ 1 to 1 1/2 hrs.

Lease Services:

- \$675 half lease includes all the benefits of full board and training with use of horse 3 days a week and 2 lessons/week
- \$1,325 full lease includes full board and training and up to 4 lessons per week.
- It is customary (for the industry) that show horse owners charge an annual fee of 30% of the value of the horse.

Show Services:

- \$55 per day fee per horse. Starts the day the horse arrives at show.
- \$20 per professional competition ride for horses in training
- \$50 per day grooming charges (mandatory)
- Hauling fees (vary depending on distance to show and amount of horses)
- \$50/day use of Trainer's horse
- Trainer Lodging when applicable

Your responsibilities as an owner at shows:

- Prior to show entry closing date submit a deposit of \$200 for schooling show, \$500 for in town rated shows, \$1000 out of town rated show to Los Lagos Equestrian Inc. (this will go toward your final show bill from your trainer).
- Leave a check made out to the horse show in question for your stall, nominating fee, and show entry deposit (to be sent with your entry)
- Be at the show to leave a check for your entries before the show starts (so we can pick up the horse competition number) or send a check with your trainer (we will carefully review the show office charges and close out the check for you if you are not able)
